


# Protecta FR Collar - Plasterboard Wall Plastic Pipes up to 40mm Bundled

### Installation Instructions

- For sealing pipe bundles, a Protecta FR Collar is installed on both sides of the wall.
- Before fitting the collar ensure that any gaps between the pipes and the separating element are sealed. Gaps between the pipes and the construction below 8mm must have a bead of Protecta FR Acrylic to cover the opening, and for gaps 8mm or above, the seal must be plugged with FR Acrylic to the depth of the plasterboard.
- Place a collar around the pipess and ensure that the fixing lugs are positioned tightly to the surface of the wall so that the anchors/fixings can be inserted fully.
- Where the surface is uneven, apply a sealing bead of Protecta® FR Acrylic between the wall and the collar.
- Attach the collar with steel screws, anchors or fixings that are suitable for the number of boards that form the wall.
- 6. On sites where the penetration size is greater than the bundle diameter and/or thebundle is on an angle, an oversized collar can be used. Protecta® FR Collars are tested 'oversize', i.e. the internal diameter of the collar can be larger than the pipes.
